


ANNUAL REPORT

AIDS DAY:-


On 01-12-2019 World AIDS day was celebrated with an awareness rally in the community followed by an expert talk on the topic "Know AIDS No AIDS"


REPUBLIC DAY [26TH JANUARY] :-

On 30th April an awareness program was held at College Campus.






9. BIBARTANA (RAJYAPURASKAR EXAM PRACTICAL TEST) CAMP 2022:

- At last, the day has spent very well with a lot of memorable & enjoy full moments.




12. ONE-DAY ORPHANAGE CAMP 2023:

- At last, the day has spent very well with a lot of memorable, experienceable & enjoy full moments.




13. ONE-DAY CAMPUS CLEANLINESS PROGRAMME 2023:

- At last, we have spent the day with a lot of enjoyable & experienceable moments.




15. MAHASHIVARATRI (JAGAR) SERVICE CAMP 2023:


❖ Objectives:

- Actually, there was a planning for providing the services at the Lingaraj Temple and as per the main purpose of the camp, they have provided their services & some act of kindness to the innocent pilgrims & devotees as their duties.
- In this occasion, they have done their duties by controlling the crowd of the devotees & pilgrims, controlling the traffic on the road, making the devotees to pass in a single line by one by one and sprinkling water through a small nozzle on the line of the devotees to make them little calm & relax at the crowds & hot environment.
- Also, they have arranged some Stretcher & First-Aid system to immediately carry any patient or casualties from the crowd area to the ambulance or to the nearest safest place or medical.
- At last, They have returned from the camp on 19th February with a lot of satisfaction of their services and with some memorable & learning full experiences.



About:

The National Service Scheme (NSS) is an Indian government-sponsored flagship for public service program conducted by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports of the Government of India. Popularly known as NSS, the scheme was launched in Gandhi's Centenary year in 1969. Aimed at developing student's personality through community service, NSS is a voluntary association of young people in Colleges, Universities and at +2 level working for a *saahas*- community (esp. Villages) heritage.

History:

After independence the University Grants Commission, headed by S. Radhakrishnan, recommended the introduction of voluntary national service in academic institutions. This idea was again considered by the Central Advisory Board of Education (CABE) at its meeting in January, 1950; after examining the idea and the experiences of other countries in this field, the board recommended that students and teachers should devote time to voluntary manual work. In the draft first Five-Year Plan adopted by the government in 1952, the need for social and labour service by Indian students for one year was stressed. In 1958 Jawaharlal Nehru, in a letter to the chief ministers, considered the idea of social service as a prerequisite for graduation. He directed the Ministry of Education to formulate a suitable scheme for the introduction of national service into academic institutions.

Aim:

The programme aims to instilling the ideas of social welfare in students, and to provide service to society without bias. NSS volunteers work to ensure that everyone who is needy gets help to enhance their standard of living and lead a life of dignity. In doing so, volunteers learn from people in villages how to lead a good life despite a scarcity of resources. It also provides help in natural and man-made disasters by providing food, clothing and first aid to the disaster's victims.





About:

The National Service Scheme (NSS) is an Indian government-sponsored flagship for public service program conducted by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports of the Government of India. Popularly known as NSS, the scheme was launched in Gandhiji's Centenary year in 1969. Aimed at developing student's personality through community service, NSS is a voluntary association of young people in Colleges, Universities and at +2 level working for a campus-community (esp. Villages) linkage.

History:

After independence the University Grants Commission, headed by S. Radhakrishnan, recommended the introduction of voluntary national service in academic institutions. This idea was again considered by the Central Advisory Board of Education (CABE) at its meeting in January, 1950, after examining the idea and the experiences of other countries in this field, the board recommended that students and teachers should devote time to voluntary manual work. In the draft first Five-Year Plan adopted by the government in 1952, the need for social and labour service by Indian students for one year was stressed. In 1953 Jawaharlal Nehru, in a letter to the chief ministers, considered the idea of social service as a prerequisite for graduation. He directed the Ministry of Education to formulate a suitable scheme for the introduction of national service into academic institutions.

Aim:

The programme aims to instilling the idea of social welfare in students, and to provide service to society without bias. NSS volunteers work to ensure that everyone who is needy gets help to enhance their standard of living and lead a life of dignity. In doing so, volunteers learn from people in villages how to lead a good life despite a scarcity of resources. It also provides help in natural and man-made disasters by providing food, clothing and first aid to the disaster's victims.
