About the institution

Established in 1987 on the sacred banks of the river Prachi near Adaspur village, Cuttack district, Udayanath Autonomous College of Science & Technology (UN College) stands as a beacon of higher education in rural Odisha. Founded through the philanthropic contribution of Sri Udayanath Sahoo and shaped by the visionary leadership of Founder President S.J. Trilochan Kanungo, a renowned economist and parliamentarian, formally transferred the institution to its permanent campus, Prachi Jnanapitha, on 3rd December 1986.

Seated on 30 acres of land close to Kenduli, the birthplace of classical poet Jayadev, the college commenced undergraduate programmes in Arts (1991), Science (1992), and Commerce (1993), steadily expanding into postgraduate education and professional streams. Included under UGC Sections 2(f) and 12(B) in 2003, accredited B+ by NAAC in 2006, and conferred Autonomous Status by UGC in January 2009, the college today offers over 46 programmes across disciplines including Science, Arts, Commerce, and Information Technology, nurturing more than 4,600 students guided by over 200 dedicated faculty and staff.
